### **SureView Announces Integration with Brivo to Offer Video-based Access Control Monitoring**

*Tampa, Florida* - SureView Systems, developer of Immix<sup>®</sup>, the leading video-based automation platform for the security alarm industry, and Brivo Systems, leader in Software as a Service (SaaS) applications for security management, announce the successful integration of Brivo's ACS WebService<sup>®</sup> hosted physical access control system with Immix. Central Stations and Command Centers can now leverage the power of Brivo's SaaS model for deploying access control with the event-based monitoring of Immix. Operators manage the alarm event by comparing the clips to live video feeds, conducting a two-way audio talk down, or escalating the issue to security personnel or law enforcement.
